Driving Directions

To Barbara Flynn's:

Take I-5 to SR520, turn right at Hwy. 202 (Redmond/Fall City Road). Turn right at Gray Barn Nursery onto Sahalee Way NE. Left at NE 14th St., then right at 232nd Pl. NE. The house is on the left.

To John Flintoff's:

From Barbara Flynn's garden on 232nd PI NE head north, and turn left onto NE 14th St. Turn right onto 228th Ave NE. (Sahalee Way NE). Turn left onto Hwy. 202 (Redmond/Fall City Road). Hwy 202 becomes Redmond Way, then NE 85th St. Turn right onto I-405 heading north. At Exit 23 off-ramp merge onto Hwy. 522 toward Bothell. This becomes Bothell Way. Continue east on Bothell Way (Hwy 522) thru Kenmore to Lake Forest Park, Turn right at Lake Forest Park onto Ballinger Way NE (Hwy. 104). Turn slight right onto 25th Ave NE. Right onto NE 203rd St. House is on the

right.
